# A Practical Application-Answer Example

## 1. Question

Why do you want to become a bus driver?

## 2. Weak answer

I like driving and I need a stable job.

## 3. Why the weak answer is risky

This answer is too basic and focuses mainly on the applicant's needs. It does not show passenger safety, customer service, reliability, procedure awareness or understanding of the role.

## 4. Stronger complete answer

I want to become a bus driver because the role involves safe driving, responsibility, customer service and working with the public. I understand that it is not just about driving a vehicle, but about carrying passengers safely, following procedures and representing the employer professionally. I believe my reliability, calm approach and willingness to learn would suit this type of role.

## 5. Why the stronger answer works

- It links the answer to safety, passengers and professional responsibility.
- It shows awareness that bus driving is a public-facing role.
- It gives the employer useful signals: reliability, calm judgement and willingness to learn.

## 6. Adapt honestly reminder

Use the structure to build your own answer. Keep the safety, passenger-care and procedure points, but adapt the wording so it accurately reflects your own experience, licence position and work history.
